- Denial of Recreational Sports Grant request of \$1500 for trip to Australia – approved \$500 (maximum allowed by policy) (2-3)
- Allowing full access to the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of city hall without any restrictions or protections for employees (2-3)
- Adoption of Open Government Ordinance (3-1)
- Community Development Block Grant Funding Priorities (3-2)
